Below are the weather related procedures for ESE in case of a school delay or cancellation.

- If CCS is on a 2 Hour Delay...
The AM Program will open at the normal time (7am), and remain open until the students are dismissed for class (usually around 10:05am). Breakfast will still be offered to students who attend. Any student enrolled in the ESE program may attend. If the student does not normally attend the AM program, the cost for that day is \$11. Students who are not enrolled in attend ESE, are always welcome. In this instance, the cost to attend would also include a \$40 registration fee for the student's first visit and paperwork will be required upon drop-off. PM Program will run as normal. If school is cancelled while the AM program is running parents will be contacted by phone and will need to pick students up no later than 10AM. There will be a \$1 late fee per minute.
- If school is canceled...ESE will also be canceled. There will be NO AM or PM program.
- If school is released prior to the end of the normal school day (2:35)...ESE and CCS staff will work together to get your child home as indicated with CCS.
